



Dear Charleston National Residents,

This letter is an update of our plan for opening the pool complex on May 18th according to operating guidelines issued by South Carolina authorities.

Human safety will remain our primary consideration in determining when and how we will operate our pool complex. One thing seems clear in our analysis – we are not willing to accept the risk involved in operating our pool complex for any period of the day without the presence of paid supervision. That said, this note is also for the purpose of soliciting help from the community, for residents to serve as paid attendants to operate this facility under strict guidelines for safety. Our planned, manned operating hours are intended to be 8 am to 6 pm daily. The people who do this work will operate the facility according to a strict set of rules which will include the following: 50 person maximum, mandatory hand washing before entering, Pool Monitor records the date, name of visitor, temperature, and authorized access number including the issued pool card. Residents should bring their own chairs, and we will make some furniture available if necessary only after it is thoroughly sanitized with disinfectant. Our pool monitors will be tasked with firmly instructing pool users on a set of rules specifically designed to maintain good safety while making this asset available to the community (see attached list of additional rules). Non compliance with these rules will not be an option. All users of the pool complex will be required to fully cooperate with these rules (and the monitors) without exception. We will not open our pools unattended for any period of time during this period of concern related to Covid 19. To be clear, our pools will not operate during any time period without a monitor.

We sincerely want to provide our community an enjoyable but SAFE way to use our pools during this time. We believe this will be best accomplished by hiring mature, committed members of the community to help us do this job. We need your help to achieve this goal and sincerely appreciate those of you who are willing and able to help us accomplish this for the benefit of the community.
